Water quality sampling

Be careful to keep the supply of test strips in the tube dry. Replace the cap before taking a sample.

Nitrate and Nitrite test strips

- Dip test strip into running water (at least an arm’s length from shore) for 1 second and remove.
- Do not shake excess water from the strip and hold the test strip pad side up for 30 seconds
- Compare the color of the pad to the reference color chart on the tube, and record nitrate.

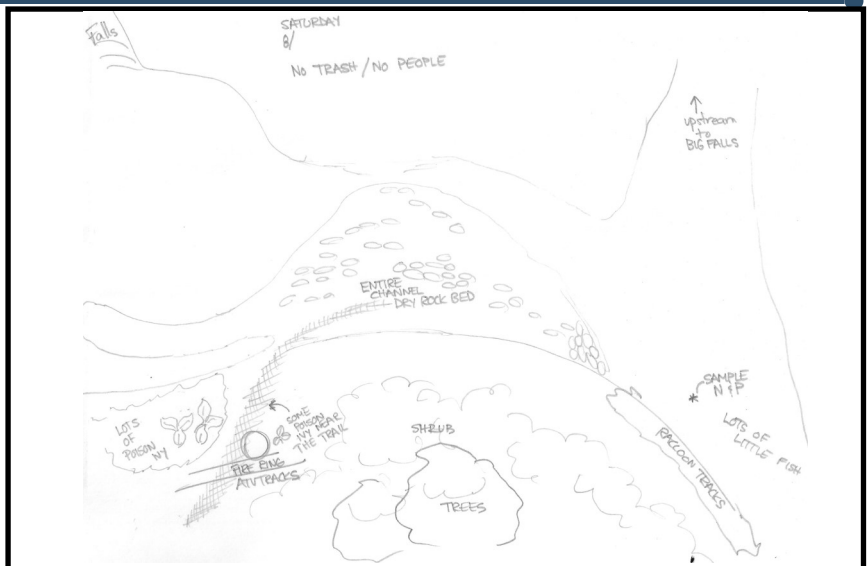
Phosphate test strips

- Dip test strip into running water (at least an arm’s length from shore) for 5 seconds and remove.
- Do not shake excess water from the strip and hold the test strip pad side up for 45 seconds
- Compare the color of the pad to the reference color chart on the tube, and record phosphate.

Make a sketch of the site on the back of this worksheet

- Indicate sample collection sites
- Mark areas of significant sediment deposition or erosion
- Knotweed, parsnip, or poison ivy
- Signs of wildlife (tracks, scat) amphibians, fish



Raboin Farm Access at Lowell—Westfield Town Line
